Judges C. Ray Mullins, Paul W. Bonapfel and Mary Grace Diehl of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia have asked the Federal Judicial Center (FJC) to survey members of the Bar to assess their level of performance. The survey is part of each of those Judges' on-going commitment to provide the highest level of public service possible. The FJC is the research and education organization for the federal courts and is located in Washington, D.C.

In the near future, the FJC will send an email to each attorney who has practiced before one or more of these three Judges. The email will explain how to access and complete an online questionnaire.

Research staff at the FJC will compile and analyze completed questionnaires, and will provide each Judge with a summary of the responses and a compilation of the comments that are received. They will not provide a Judge with the identity of people who responded, if that information becomes known to them. The results are exclusively for each of the Judge's use in improving their performance; they will not be provided to anyone other than the Judge and they will not be used in the reappointment process.
