ORDER

On December 15, 2008, the Court entered General Order 10-2008 to adopt Interim
Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I.¹ Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I implemented the National Guard
and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008 which provided to certain members of the National
Guard and Reserves a temporary exclusion from the means test requirements in chapter 7
bankruptcy cases. In accordance with General Order 10-2008, Interim Rule 1007-I applied to
cases commenced in the three-year period beginning December 19, 2008. The recently
enacted National Guard and Reservist Debt Relief Extension Act of 2011, Pub. L. No. 11264, extends this means testing exclusion period for an additional four years through
December 18, 2015. Accordingly, effective immediately, the temporary exclusion period
under Interim Rule 1007-I as adopted by this Court shall apply to bankruptcy cases

The Court adopted Amended Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I in General Order No. 11-2009 and General Order No. 12-2010.
