ORDER

Whereas on April 20, 2005, the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the "Act") was enacted into law; and

Whereas most provisions of the Act were effective on October 17, 2005; and

Whereas the Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules ("Rules Committee") prepared Interim Bankruptcy Rules designed to implement the substantive and procedural changes mandated by the Act, and the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Judicial Conference of the United States also approved these Interim Bankruptcy Rules and recommended the adoption of the Interim Bankruptcy Rules to provide uniform procedures for implementing the Act; and

Whereas pursuant to General Order No. 1-2005 (Bankr. N.D. Ga., Oct. 5, 2005), the Court adopted the Interim Rules as prepared by the Rules Committee for cases in the Northern District of Georgia filed on or after October 17, 2005; and

Whereas the Rules Committee has prepared an amended Interim Rule 1007 to implement amended and new Official Forms which have been approved by the Rules Committee, the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure, and the Judicial Conference of the United States;

NOW THEREFORE, the Judges of this Court adopt amended Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007 as prepared by the Rules Committee, to be effective October 17, 2006, until further Order of the Court.
