J U D G M E N T

Plaintiff named above filed a motion for summary judgment on Count I of his complaint seeking a determination that a certain federal district court award, entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant-Debtor based upon a judgment entered on November 16, 1994 in an action styled *Matthew Ezekiel Haramis v. Preston Mitchell*, Civil Action No. 93-F-1547, in the United States District Court for the District of Colorado, in the amount of \$150,000.00, comprised of compensatory and punitive damages, be excepted from discharge as arising from a "willful and malicious injury" under 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(6). Based upon a review of the record, and for the reasons set forth in the Court's Order entered contemporaneously herewith, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the motion of Plaintiff for summary judgment on Count I of his complaint, be, and the same hereby is, **granted**, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that said obligation as referenced herein be, and the same hereby is, **excepted** from discharge and same is nondischargeable by reason of 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(6).

The Clerk is directed to serve a copy of this Judgment upon counsel for Plaintiff, counsel for Defendant-Debtor, the Chapter 7 Trustee, and the United States Trustee.
