**ORDER**

The above-styled Chapter 13 case is before the Court on Brian R. Cahn's ("Debtors' counsel") Application for Supplemental Compensation ("Application"). (Docket No. 35). The matter came on for hearing on February 24, 2010. Present at the hearing was Brian R. Cahn. In the Application, Debtors' counsel sought supplemental compensation in the amount of \$300 for services performed on a post-confirmation modification of Debtors' plan. In the Disclosure of Compensation of Attorney for Debtor, attached to Debtors' petition, Debtors' counsel certified that he had agreed to accept \$3950 as a base fee, which would not cover certain specifically identified services. The post-confirmation modification for which Debtors' counsel now seeks compensation was a modification to provide for the surrender of debtors' interest in real property. That service is not in

the list of services excluded from the base fee that Debtors' counsel agreed to accept. Therefore, it appears that Debtors' counsel's base fee covers this service and that Debtors' counsel is not entitled to additional compensation for this service. Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED** that Debtors' counsel's Application for Supplemental Compensation is **DENIED**.

The Clerk shall serve a copy of this Order upon Debtors, Debtors' counsel, the Chapter 13 Trustee, and the U.S. Trustee.
