**ORDER REQUIRING SUPPLEMENT**

On April 15, 2009, this case was closed without entry of a discharge because Debtor had failed to file the financial management course certificate. Debtor filed the financial management course certificate April 15, 2009, approximately two and a half hours after the case was closed. On April 29, 2009, Debtor filed a motion to reopen this case to file the certificate and obtain her discharge (the "Motion") [Doc. No. 37].

Debtor included in the Motion a request that the \$260 reopening filing fee be refunded. The Motion, however, provides no discussion of grounds to support refund of the filing fee. The bar date in this case was March 30, 2009. The Chapter 7 Trustee's No Distribution Report had been filed January 27, 2009. From March 30, 2009, onward, the closing of the case was imminent. The certificate is dated April 2, 2009. Debtor provides no discussion of the reasons that filing of the certificate was delayed to April 15, 2009. The mere fact that the certificate was filed so close in time to the closing of the case does not change the fact that the certificate was filed *after* the case was closed. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that, within 14 days of the date of entry of this order, Debtor may file a supplement to the Motion to provide additional facts and argument regarding the request to refund the reopening filing fee. If no supplement is filed within the time allowed, that portion of the motion will be deemed denied.

**The Clerk, U.S. Bankruptcy Court, is directed to serve** a copy of this order upon Debtor, Debtor's attorney, the Chapter 7 Trustee, and all creditors and parties in interest.
