ORDER

Before the Court is the Motion to Withdraw as Counsel filed by Paul H. Wyatt, attorney of record for William Turner Harris, Jr., the debtor in the above-referenced bankruptcy proceeding. Although the Motion is unopposed, the Motion does not comply with Local Bankruptcy Rule 9010-5, which requires an attorney who wishes to withdraw to provide the client with fourteen (14) days' notice of the intent to withdraw *prior to* filing the motion to withdraw. Here, the letter was mailed to the client on the same day the Motion was filed. Further, the notice to the client must state that the client has fourteen (14)

days to object to the motion to withdraw. Counsel's notice states that the client has ten (10) days to object to the Motion.

For these reasons, the Motion to Withdraw as Counsel is hereby **DENIED without prejudice.**
