PLEASE NOTE: **Motions for relief from stay** must be filed and served at least two (2) weeks prior to the hearing date selected. Co-Debtor Motions must be filed and served at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the hearing date selected.

EMERGENCY HEARINGS: File the Motion and the request for an emergency hearing, explaining why the need to shorten notice time. (Once on the docket, a contact to the courtroom deputy will help expedite the process). Once the Court reviews, and if approved, the Court will enter an Order and Notice that grants the request to expedite the hearing and schedules the Motion for hearing. Movant Attorney will serve the Order & Notice as the Order directs.

YOU MAY NOT RESET A MATTER MORE THAN **TWICE** WITHOUT COURT PERMISSION. Contact the Courtroom Deputy.
