SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED ORDERS USING THE E-ORDERS PROGRAM THAT IS A PART OF CM/ECF IS PREFERRED TO PAPER ORDERS AND WILL PERMIT YOUR ORDERS TO BE PROCESSED FASTER. AT PRESENT USE OF E-ORDERS IS NOT REQUIRED, HOWEVER, AND YOU MAY DELIVER PAPER ORDERS TO CHAMBERS.

THERE IS ALSO A CHANGE IN DATES AND TIMES FOR SCHEDULING CERTAIN MOTIONS IN CHAPTER 13 CASES ON AND AFTER SEPTEMBER 4, 2007. SEE PAGE 2.

Attorneys must set hearings on most matters in accordance with Judge Massey's Open Calendar Procedure. The categories of hearings and the dates and times on which such hearings will be held are set out below. All hearings are held in Courtroom 1404, U.S. Courthouse, 75 Spring Street, S.W., Atlanta.

Please contact Josette Glasper El at 404-215-1013 to obtain a date and time for a hearing on any matter likely to take more than 20 minutes to resolve and on any emergency matter.

Pick a date far enough in the future to give adequate notice under the applicable rules. **If there is no available hearing date for stay relief motions that is more than 14 days but less than 31 days after the filing of the motion and a movant is unwilling to consent to continue the stay, the movant's attorney must call Ms. Glasper El to obtain a special date and time for a hearing. Motions under Section 362(c)(3)(B) and (c)(4)(B) must be filed and served at least 10 days before the hearing date.**
