

**AVAILABLE OPEN CALENDAR DATES**  
**For Judge Massey**  
**(As of August 27, 2004 (9:25am))**

Attorneys must set hearings on most matters in accordance with Judge Massey's Open Calendar Procedure. The categories of hearings and the dates and times on which such hearings will be held are set out below. All hearings are held in Courtroom 1404, U.S. Courthouse, 75 Spring Street, S.W., Atlanta.

In general, the Court will hear first the matters on a calendar that will take less than 20 minutes. Matters that might take longer than 20 minutes to hear could be reset or might be heard in part and continued. Therefore, with regard to matters likely to be contested, the movant's attorney should consult with others involved and consider whether it would make more sense to obtain a specially set hearing for that matter. Contact Joy Jackson at 404-215-1013 to obtain a date and time for a hearing that is likely to take more than 20 minutes.

Note that the calendars are arranged by Chapter and that there are hearing dates specially reserved for matters in the Centennial HealthCare Corporation Chapter 11 case.
