## UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE NORTHERN DISTRICT OF GEORGIA JUDICIAL FEEDBACK SURVEYS FOR JUDGE JEFFERY W. CAVENDER AND JUDGE SAGE M. SIGLER

Judge Jeffery W. Cavender and Judge Sage M. Sigler of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia asked the <u>Federal Judicial Center</u> (FJC) to survey attorneys and trustees to obtain feedback about their judicial performance. The FJC is the research and education agency for the federal courts. The judges' decisions to ask the FJC to conduct this survey are entirely voluntary and reflect their ongoing commitment to provide the highest level of public service possible.

A separate survey will be conducted for each judge and both surveys are expected to begin during the week of **October 30th**.

For each survey, the FJC will send an invitation email to attorneys and trustees who have practiced before the particular Bankruptcy Judge in the past four years. The email will explain how to access and complete an online questionnaire.

The survey procedure is set up so responses are anonymous, even to the researchers. For each survey, research staff at the FJC will compile the responses and provide the relevant judge a report. The report will include the comments that are provided in response to the open-ended questions and tables or figures aggregating the results for the closed-ended questions. The survey report is exclusively for that judge's use in improving his or her performance.
