




WHEREAS absent an appropriation or continuing resolution, employees of other federal agencies who may have matters before the Court, including the Internal Revenue Service, the Small Business Administration, the Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Department of Education and the Department of Agriculture, with limited exceptions, also are prohibited from working, even on a voluntary basis,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. all hearings, including those in adversary proceedings, involving any claim, lien or other interest of the United States of America, including its agencies, scheduled for the week of January 22, 2018 are continued and shall be placed on the next appropriate calendar;
2. all current deadlines, including those in adversary proceedings, in matters involving a claim, lien or other interest of the United States of America, including its agencies, shall be extended through and including January 30, 2018;
3. if funding is not restored by Friday, January 26, 2018, at 10:00 am, the United States Attorney shall so notify the Honorable Wendy L. Hagenau, Chief Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia, so that such further action may be taken as is just and proper; and

4. the United States Attorney shall forthwith notify the Honorable Wendy L. Hagenau, Chief Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia, once appropriations have been restored.
