

CM/ECF TRAINING FOR ATTORNEYS DOING "DEBTOR" WORK

You are invited to attend CM/ECF Training for Attorneys and staff. In the "Hands-On CM/ECF Training" class, qualified court trainers will teach you how to ~

- maneuver through the Court's Web site and CM/ECF
- retrieve data from CM/ECF
- file cases through CM/ECF
- electronically file pleadings in CM/ECF

This class is not to teach you the new law or how to use your software. It is training on how to transmit your documents via the internet using the Court's electronic case filing system.
