Be sure to pick a date far enough in the future to give adequate notice under the applicable law and rules and the Open Calendar Procedures.

Calendar calls will be conducted via video conference in Judge Baisier's Virtual Hearing Room at the times noted below. Matters that need to be heard after the second calendar call will be heard in the manner indicated below. For those purposes, matters that (i) require argument that is expected to exceed twenty (20) minutes, (ii) require the presentation of evidence, or (iii) involve a party that cannot without undue hardship appear via video conference are referred to as "In Person Matters."

Parties may attend any calendar call in person. Parties may appear in person for hearings held by video conference as long as they provide advance notice	
to the Court and the other parties. Such notice can be provided at the calendar	
call.
