NDGA Federal Student Loan Dischargeability Adversary Proceedings since November 17, 2022

- ~57 adversary proceedings in NDGA involving federal student loans since 11/17/22
 - 33 consent judgments discharging student loans
- ~\$3.7 million in student loan debt discharged through operation of the Guidance



1. Collect Information in Advance



National Student Loan Data System: (NSLDS): Review your client's student loan history



Current Income: Gather information about current household size and current income



Current Expenses: Collect information on current household expenses

2. Understand the undue hardship narrative



3. Identify the proper defendants



4. Present a well-drafted complaint

5. Serve the summons and complaint

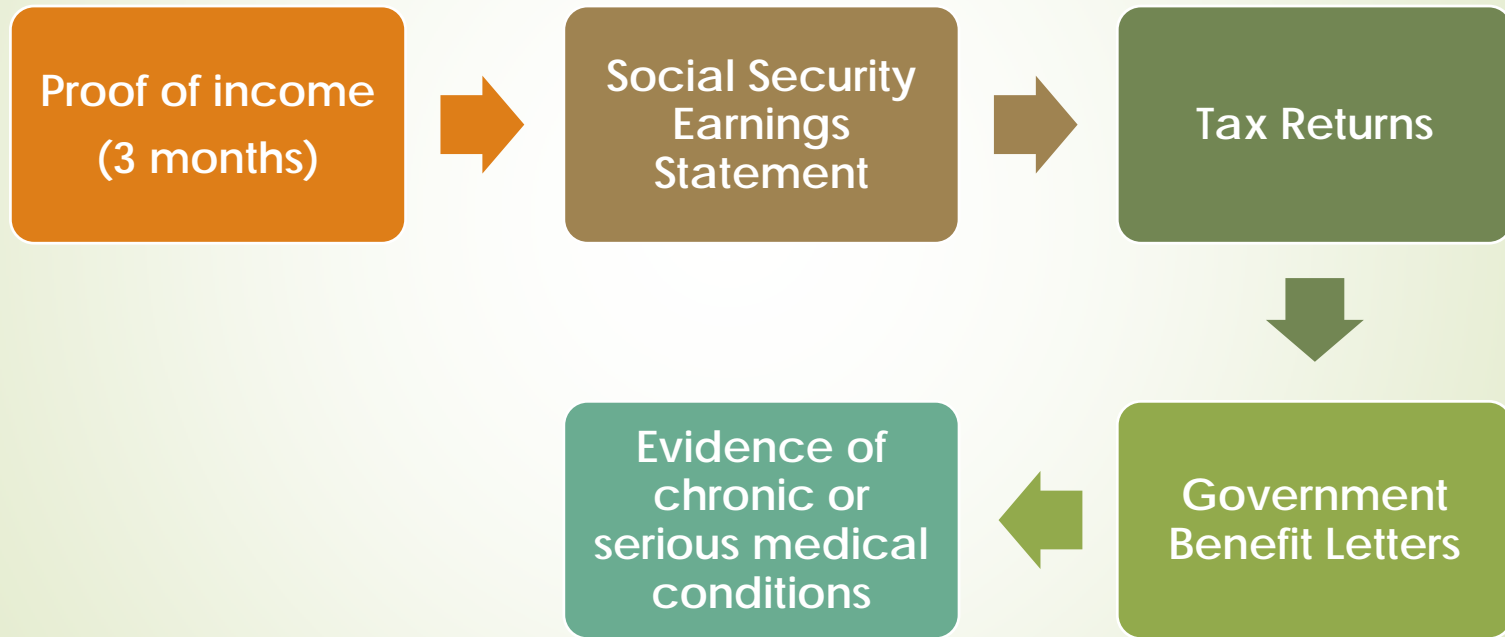


7. Seek litigation stays,
