Filing the Certification of Debtor's Original Signature Required by General Order 33-2020

General Order 33-2020 directs the filing of a certification within 30 days of electronically filing a Verified Paper that debtor's attorney has received the debtor's original signature.

The Notice (BK) and Notice (AP) events have been temporarily modified to allow for the filing of this certification.

The changes to the docketing sequence are as follows:

- 1. Bankruptcy Events → Notices → Notice (BK) or Adversary Events → Notices → Notice (AP)
- 2. Answer the question:

Are you	u filing a Certification of Debtor's Original Signature?
○Yes ○No	
Next	Clear

- 3. If Yes, the next screen will ask you to "Refer to existing events, if applicable"
 - Check the box and relate to the document(s) filed requiring the original signature
 - Verify final docket text (the Certification of Debtor's Original Signature will auto populate the docket text) and submit.
- 4. If No, you will continue to docket your Notice as you normally would using the Notice (BK) and Notice (AP) events.
