ORDER

The National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008, Pub. L. No. 110-438, enacted on October 20, 2008 (the "Act"), amends § 707(b)(2)(D) of the Bankruptcy Code to provide temporary exclusion from the bankruptcy means test for certain members of the National Guard and reserve components of the Armed Forces. The Judicial Conference of the United States has approved Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I which amends Bankruptcy Rule 1007 to take account of this legislation. This Court hereby adopts Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I. Consistent with the Act, Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I will apply to cases commenced in the three-year period beginning December 19, 2008.
