## **ORDER**

This Order is effective as to all pending cases and cases filed on or after the date of the entry of this order. This Order supersedes General Order No. 8-2007 entered on January 9, 2007. Section 1326(a)(1)(C) of the Bankruptcy Code requires a debtor in a case under Chapter 13 to make adequate protection payments to certain secured creditors prior to confirmation of a Chapter 13 plan. In order to better implement this provision, it is hereby Ordered as follows:

If a debtor elects to make pre-confirmation adequate protection payments to the Chapter 13 Trustee to be disbursed to secured creditors, the Chapter 13 Trustee is authorized to make such disbursements and to assess and collect the Trustee's administrative fee. If the case is dismissed or converted prior to confirmation of the plan, the Trustee shall disburse the adequate protection payments prior to disbursing attorney's fees pursuant to General Order 18-2015.
