ASSIGNMENT OF MULTIPLE CASE FILINGS

The Court entered Amended and Restated General Order 47-2022 on March 1, 2024 to assist in the orderly conduct of the business of the Court, to promote uniformity and efficiency in the administration of cases, and to minimize abuses of the bankruptcy system. This Order supersedes Amended and Restated General Order 47-2022 and is effective January 13, 2025. It is

ORDERED that upon the commencement of a case under Title 11 of the United States

Code in this District by a Debtor (including a spouse, business partner, or affiliate of the debtor,
hereinafter "Debtor") who is a Debtor in a pending case in this District, or in a case filed within
the five (5) years immediately prior to the filing date of the new case, the Clerk of Court is
authorized and directed to assign the newly filed case to the Bankruptcy Judge to whom the
earlier case was assigned.

If the previous Bankruptcy Judge is unavailable, the case will be randomly assigned following standard procedure. If more than one (1) case of the Debtor has been filed within the prior five (5) years, the newly filed case shall be assigned to the Bankruptcy Judge to whom the most recently filed prior case was assigned.
