


GENERAL ORDER UPDATING PROCEDURES AND FORMS
RELATED TO APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE

The Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia (the “Court”) establish the procedures for a non-resident attorney to apply for permission to appear *pro hac vice* and practice in a particular case before the Court (the “PHV Application Procedures”).

Effective April 1, 2026, the PHV Application Procedures are updated to provide for the electronic filing of the application and payment of the requisite filing fee via the Court’s Electronic Case Filing System.

The PHV Application Procedures and required forms are available on the Court’s website at www.ganb.uscourts.gov and, to the extent the PHV Application Procedures or related forms change, the Clerk will post the changes on the Court’s website. This order is effective to adopt and implement such changes as they may occur.
