VACATING GENERAL ORDERS NO. 1-2005 AND NO. 7-2006

ORDER

When the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the "Act") was enacted into law on April 20, 2005, the Judicial Conference of the United States prepared Interim Bankruptcy Rules for cases filed on or after October 17, 2005 (the "Interim Rules") to implement the Act. This Court adopted these Interim Rules in General Orders No. 1-2005 and No. 7-2006.

The Supreme Court of the United States has submitted to the United States Congress new and amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules") which supercede the Interim Rules. These Bankruptcy Rules will take effect on December 1, 2008. Accordingly, General Orders No. 1-2005 and No. 7-2006 shall each stand vacated as of December 1, 2008.
