
AUTHORIZATION OF ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT FOR NON-ATTORNEY TRUSTEES

Effective immediately, because certain panel trustees appointed by the Office of the United States Trustee in Chapter 7 and Chapter 11 Sub V cases are non-attorneys and are unable to obtain a "blue card" that allows the holder to bring electronic equipment into the United States Courthouses in the Northern District of Georgia (the "NDGA Courthouses"), this order establishes that in all cases in which a non-attorney trustee has been appointed, such non-attorney trustee is hereby authorized to enter the NDGA Courthouses with cellular telephones and other electronic devices with cameras or recording capability. It is hereby

ORDERED that Gregory S. Hays, Tracey L. Montz, Gary M. Murphey and John T. Whaley, are authorized to bring cellular telephones and other electronic devices with cameras or recording capability into NDGA Courthouses. It is further

ORDERED that this authority shall remain effective until further order of the Court, or termination of the above-listed individuals' term as trustee.
