

## In-Person Appearances in Judge Hagenau's Courtroom

Beginning June 7, 2021, Judge Hagenau will permit in-person appearances as set forth below.

Chapter 13: The calendar call will continue to be telephonic. Matters marked ready will be heard at 1:30. The attorney or party for the ready matters must appear via Judge Hagenau's video personal room or in person, at the option of the person appearing. Evidentiary hearings will presumptively be in person unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

Chapter 7: The calendar call and the non-evidentiary hearing on any **Motions for Relief from Stay** will continue to be telephonic. The calendar call for **Miscellaneous Matters** will continue to be telephonic (except as set out below). The matters marked ready from the Miscellaneous Calendar will be heard at the conclusion of the calendar call. The attorney or party for the ready matters must appear via Judge Hagenau's video personal room or in person, at the option of the person appearing. If a party or person opts to appear in person, he/she may also appear at the calendar call in person. Parties are encouraged to use the Voluntary Notice Procedure set out in GO 24-2018 and to allow sufficient time between the objection deadline and the hearing date to plan accordingly. Evidentiary hearings will presumptively be in person unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

Chapter 11 (non-complex): The calendar call will continue to be telephonic (except as set out below). The matters marked ready will be heard at the conclusion of the calendar call. The attorney or party for the ready matters must appear via Judge Hagenau's video personal room or in person, at the option of the person appearing. If a party or person opts to appear in person, he/she may also appear at the calendar call in person. Parties are encouraged to use the Voluntary Notice Procedure set out in GO 24-2018 and to allow sufficient time between the objection deadline and the hearing date to plan accordingly. Evidentiary hearings will presumptively be in person unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

Chapter 11 (complex): To be determined at first day hearings.
