Pro Se Assistance Center

The Pro Se Assistance Center (PAC) is staffed by volunteer bankruptcy attorneys and law students. The PAC offers free legal guidance through 30-minute consultations to individuals who are representing themselves in a Chapter 7 bankruptcy in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia. Volunteers can provide information about the bankruptcy process and provide limited case-specific advice, but they cannot represent parties in court or file pleadings.

Our staff will reach out to confirm facts about your case, decide on the method of the consultation (either by phone or video conference), pair you with a volunteer and schedule the final date and time for your consultation. The initial call will be to complete your case information form and will not be the consultation itself.

Please note: Appointments will be limited or may be unavailable during national holidays.

What We Do:

- We provide limited legal advice and information on Ch. 7 bankruptcy related issues and questions in the Northern District of Georgia.
- We answer questions about completing forms and preparing and filing court documents.
- We provide referrals and other resource information. We may refer eligible individuals for representation by Legal Aid or pair individuals with volunteers for pro bono representation in adversary proceedings in some cases.

What We Do Not Do:

- We do not give advice on any nonbankruptcy related legal issues or cases.
- We do not complete forms on behalf of any debtor or creditor.
- We do not provide representation in court.
- We do not file pleadings on behalf of any party.
- We do not commit to an attorneyclient relationship beyond the limited relationship that exists during the consultation.
