Pro Se Assistance Center

The Pro Se Assistance Center (PAC) is staffed by volunteer bankruptcy attorneys and law students. The PAC offers free legal guidance through 30-minute consultations to individuals who are representing themselves in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court. Volunteers can provide information about the bankruptcy process and provide limited case-specific advice, but they cannot represent parties in court or file pleadings.

On our website, you can pick a 30-minute time slot on an upcoming Monday for Atlanta Legal Aid to reach out to confirm facts about your case, decide on the method of the consultation (either by phone or video conference), and schedule the final date and time for your consultation. The initial call will be to complete your case information form and will not be the consultation itself.
