If there is no available hearing date for stay relief motions that are at least 14 days but less than 31 days after the filing of the motion and a movant is unwilling to consent to continue the stay, the movant's attorney must contact Ms. Gillespie to obtain a special date and time for a hearing. Motions under Section 362(c)(3)(B) and (c)(4)(B) must be filed and served at least 10 days before the hearing date.

#### **Regarding Reaffirmation Agreements:**

The Court will schedule all hearings on reaffirmation agreements in Atlanta Division cases on a single day before the same judge, regardless of which judge is assigned to the case.
